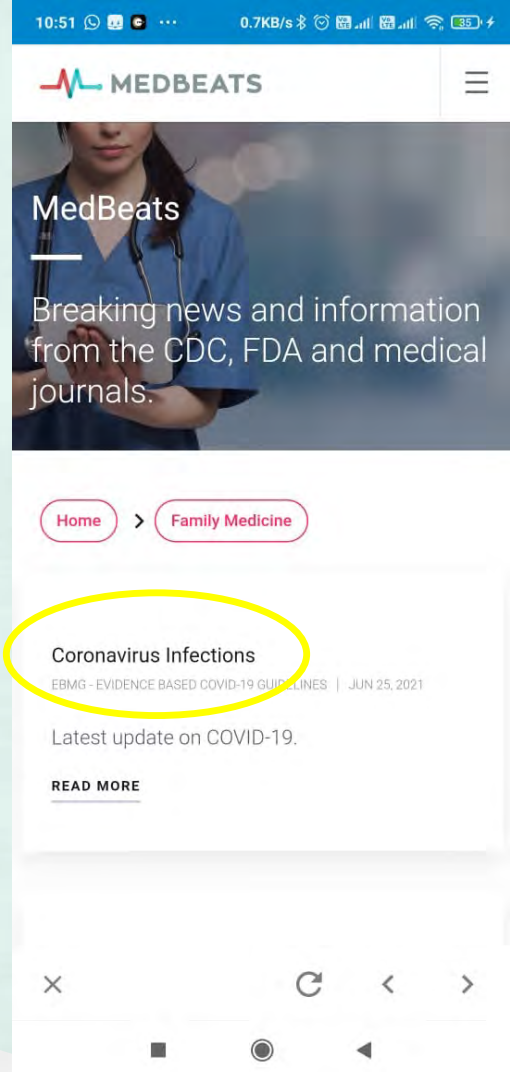

Navigation icons: close, refresh, back, forward

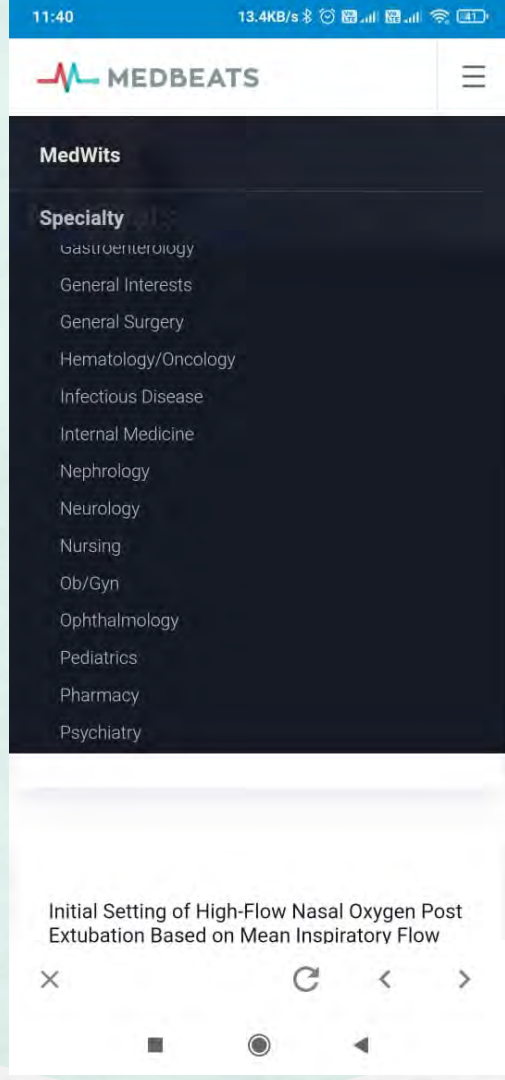


Tap on the Hamburger menu – the icon with three lines (top right hand side) to view more articles.



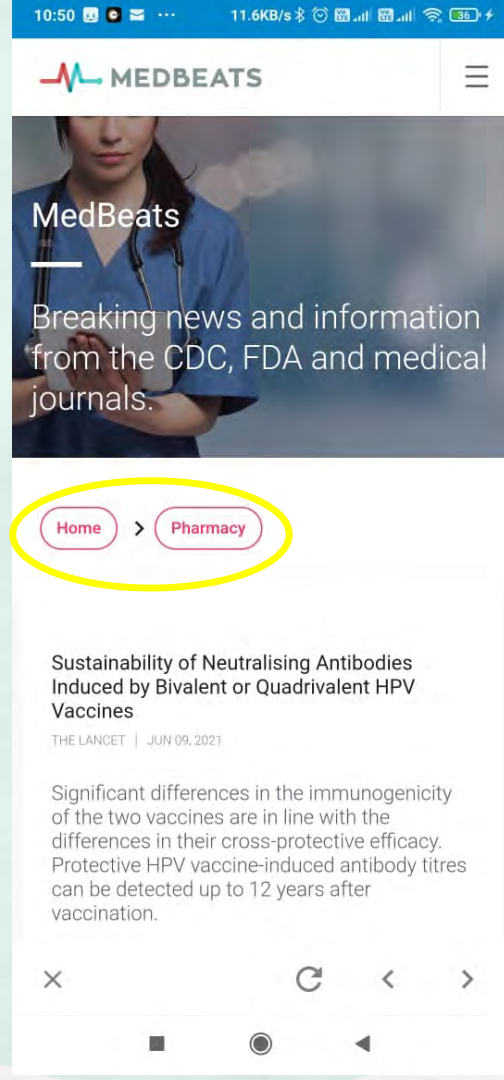


Tap on articles you want to view.



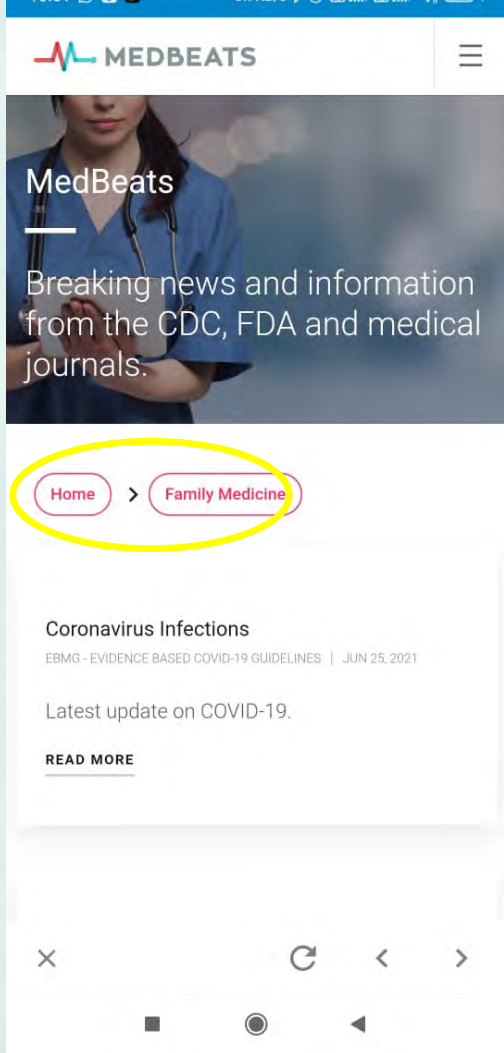


Tap on the **Pharmacy button** to view articles related to pharmacy.





Tap on the Family Medicine button to see articles/references related to family medicine.

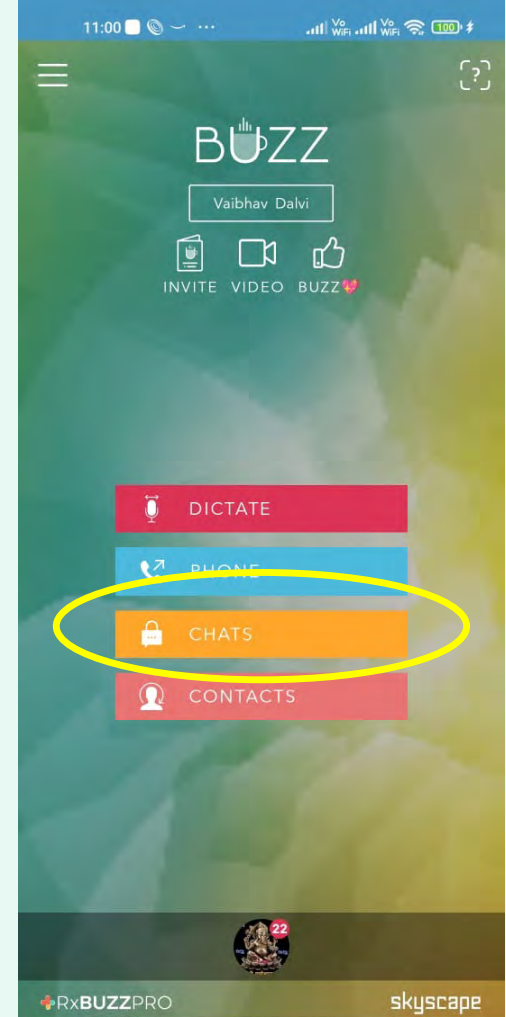




While chatting in a group, you may come across many terms or topics that you want to look up.

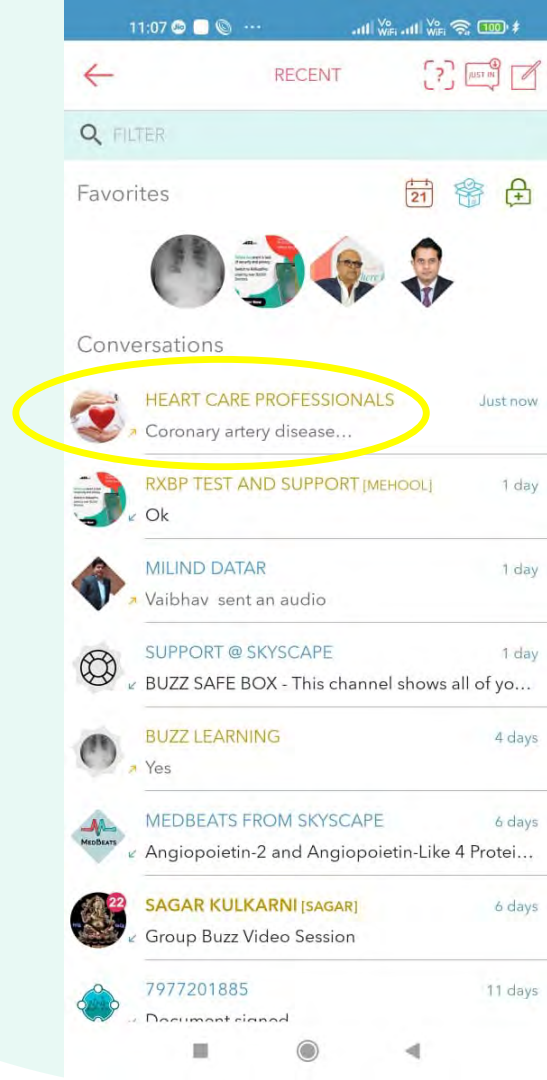

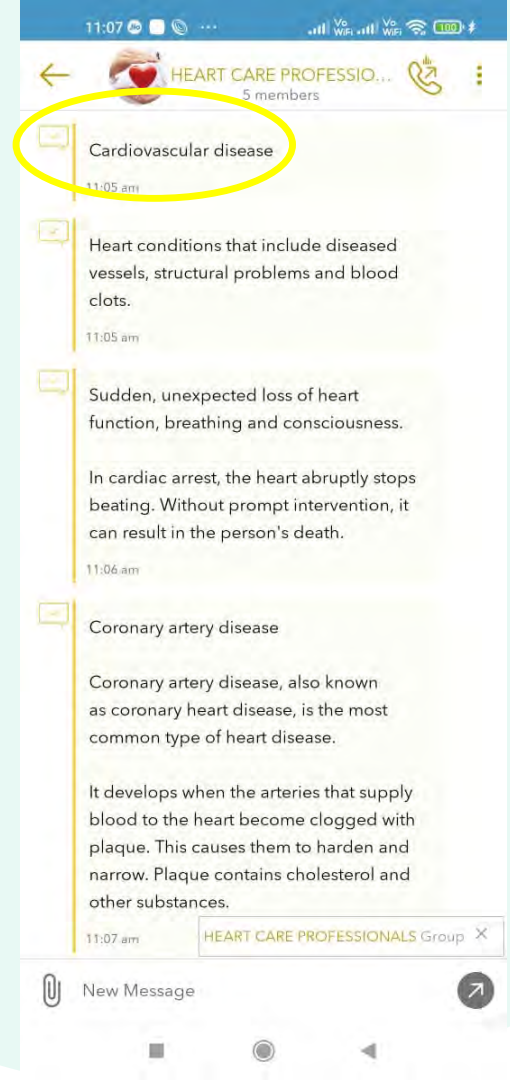

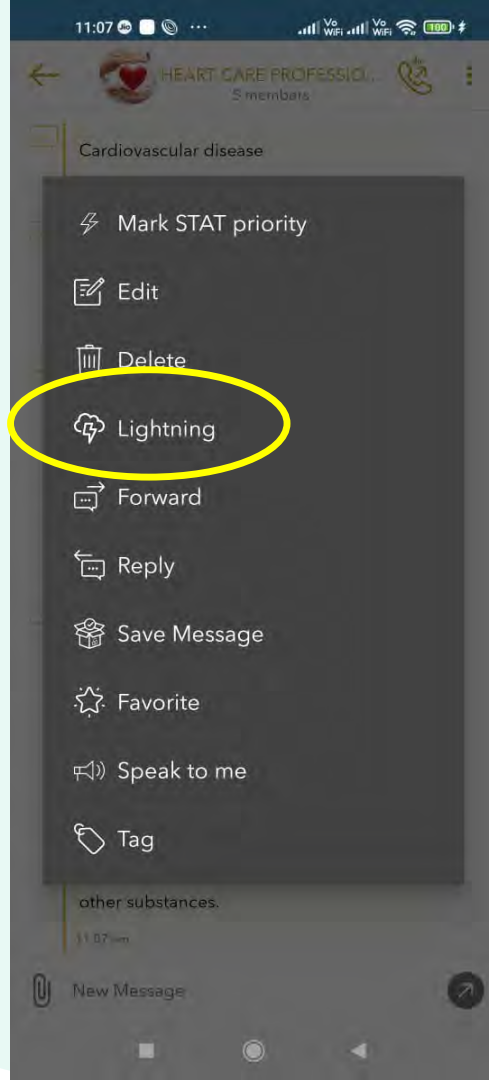

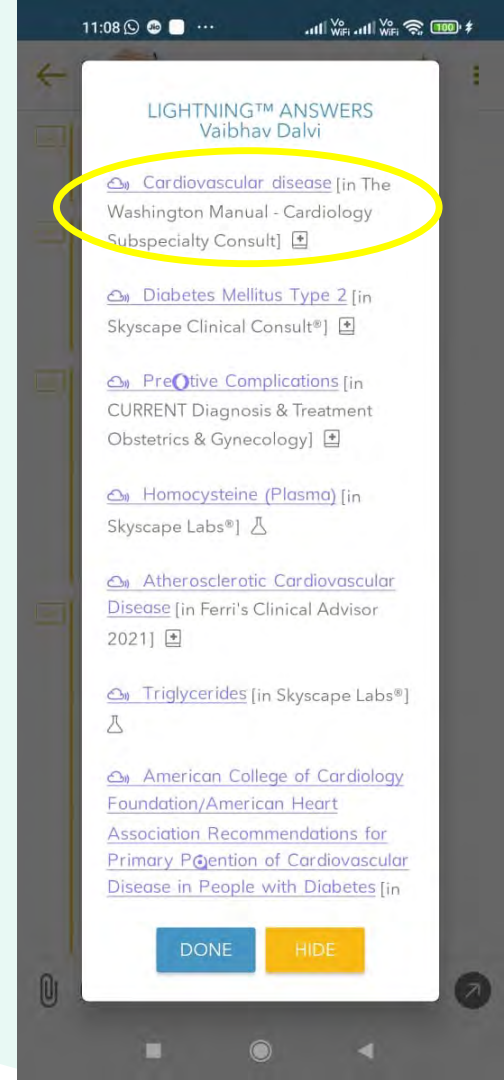

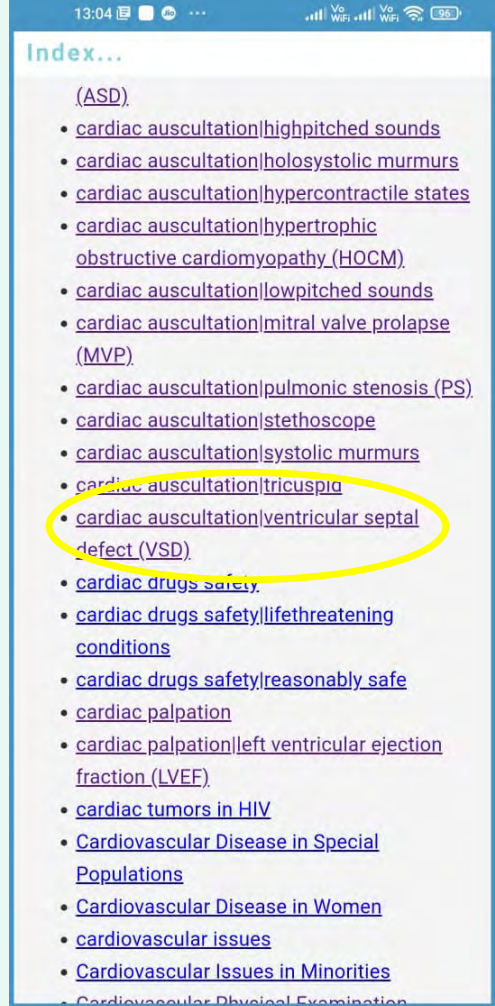

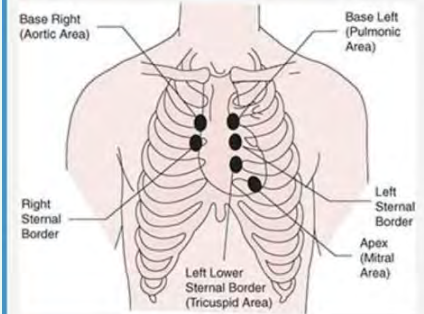
